# **Children's Mental Health Week**

This week is Children's Mental Health Week and the theme is Let's Connect.

Let's Connect is about making meaningful connections. People thrive in communities, and this connection is vital for our wellbeing. When we have healthy connections – to family, friends and others – this can support our mental health and our sense of wellbeing.

As parents and carers, you play an important role in your child's mental health. Here are a few simple ways you can support your child's understanding of connections:

- Connect with your child in everyday ways e.g. when you pick them up from school, or come in from work, try to give them your full attention
- Talk to your child about important connections- e.g. family members, friends, neighbors, etc.
- Talk to your child about their friends
- Take an interest in your child's world
- Find time to connect as a family e.g. cooking, watching a film, playing a game, going to the park or even doing the family shop together
- Try to resolve conflict and re-connect after arguments.

Safer Internet Day is celebrated each year to promote the safe and positive use of digital technology. Safer Internet Day 2023 took place on the 7th of February 2023, with celebrations and learning based around the theme 'Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online'.
