## Safer Internet Day

Safer Internet Day will take place on the 6th February. The theme is 'Together for a better internet'. In school we will be completing various activities to support the children's understanding of this.

It is really important to chat with your child regularly about staying safe online. If you are not sure where to begin, these conversation starters may help.

- Ask your children to tell you about the sites they like to visit and what they enjoy doing online. What games do you and your friends like to play online? Can you show me the websites you visit the most? Shall we play your favourite game online together?
- Ask them about how they stay safe online. What tips do they have for you, and where did they learn them? What is OK and not OK to share?
- Ask them if they know where to go for help. Where can they go to find the safety advice, privacy settings and do they know how to report or block someone?

# **Children's Mental Health Week**

Children's Mental Health Week will take place from 5-11 February 2024. The theme this year is 'My Voice Matters'. My Voice Matters is about empowering our children by providing them with the tools they need to express themselves.

As parents and carers, you play an important role in your child's mental health. Below are some top tips to help you.

1. We don't need to have just a 'one-off conversation about our mental health' – sometimes a chat on a journey or at bedtime is enough.

2. Children need to know it is okay to talk to you about all of their feelings. Please hear what they have to say, without interrupting them.

3. Please listen to them carefully and acknowledge how they are feeling.

4. Please don't worry about trying to fix things for them – they often just need to know you are there for them and understand what they are going through.

5. Sometimes they may not want to talk. Please trust that they will come to you (or another grown-up or someone their own age) when they are ready.

6. Sometimes a hug is all it takes to make them feel supported.
