Taste	Your sense of taste comes from your tongue. You can tell is something tastes bitter or sweet. You might have some tastes you like and some you don't.
Smell	You can smell using your nose. Your nose can tell if things smell nice or not nice.
Hear	Your ears let you listen to all the things around you. Your brain is able to tell what different sounds are.
Sight	Your eyes let you see all the things around you.


