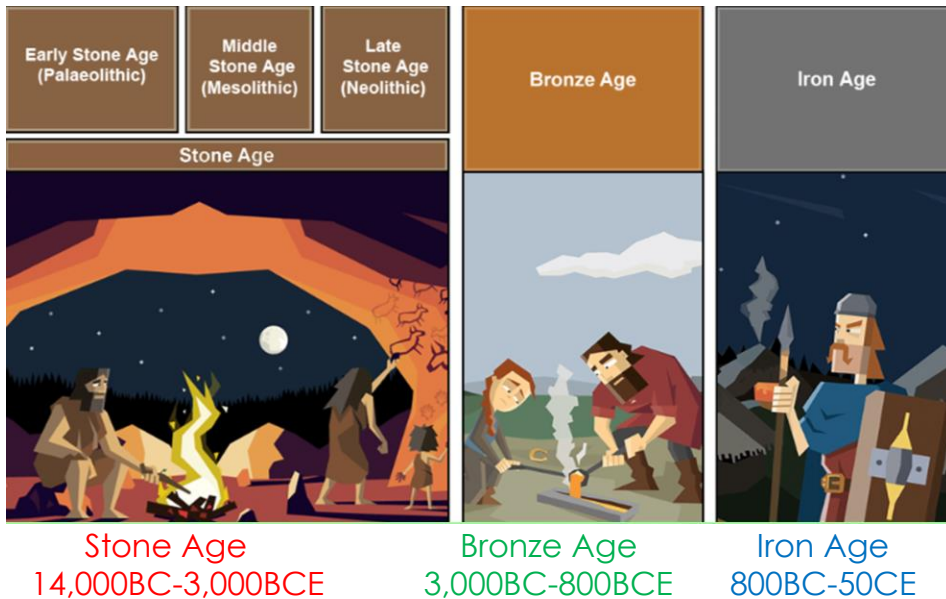


Stoneage

Key words and definitions

hunter-gatherers - people who live mainly by hunting, fishing and gathering wild fruits.

Stonehenge – A famous Stone Age monument in Wiltshire.

Bronze age/ Iron age – the periods in history that came after the Stone Age.
